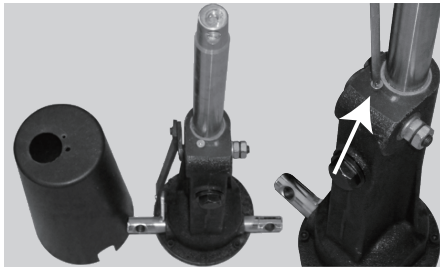


Instructions to Replace Hydraulic Pump

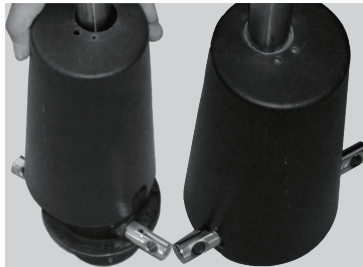
Tools Needed: Phillips head screwdriver, wrench, hammer, and Allen wrench

Set Up

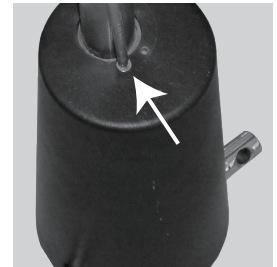
1. With the help of one or two people, lay the grooming table on its back—and not on either one of its sides—to shift its weight off of the frame. *Please note: This is a precautionary step to ensure your safety. You risk injury if you service the table while it remains standing in the upright position because the suspended table could drop on you. Please take precautions to avoid injuries.*



2. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, remove the screw from the inner core of the new hydraulic pump.

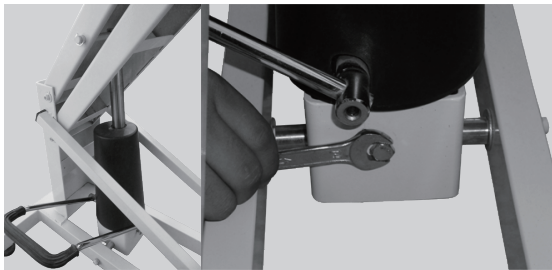


3. Cover the inner core of the hydraulic pump by using the plastic outer casing.

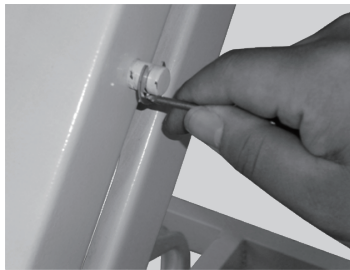


4. Using the screw provided, attach the plastic outer casing to the inner core.

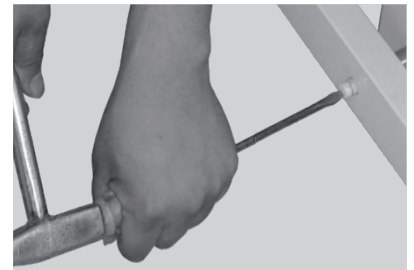
Removal of Existing Hydraulic Pump



1. Use a wrench to loosen the bolt at the base of the hydraulic pump.



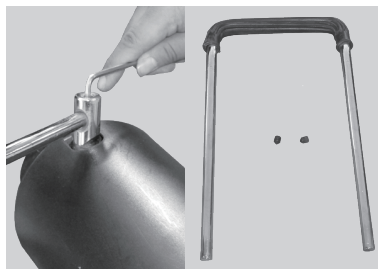
2. Use a sharp tool to pull out the retainer clip from the clevis pin on the hydraulic pump.



3. Use a hammer and metal rod to tap out the clevis pin from the pump.



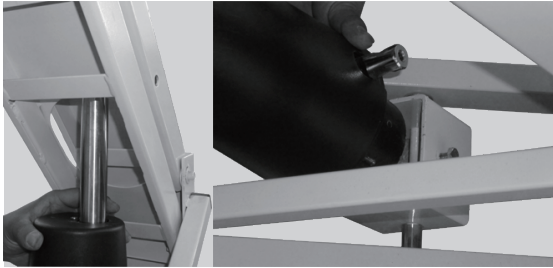
4. Carefully remove the old hydraulic pump.



5. Use an Allen wrench to remove the clamping screws and the foot lever.

Instructions to Replace Hydraulic Pump (Continued)

Install New Hydraulic Pump



1. Carefully insert the new hydraulic pump into place.
2. Use a wrench to tighten the bolt at the base of the hydraulic pump.
3. Using a hammer tap the clevis pin into place.



4. Insert the retainer clip at the right position.
5. Using an Allen wrench install the foot lever onto the new hydraulic pump.
6. The replacement is complete.
